California Transitions from Gas to Battery – California Governor California Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 1346 into law on October 9, 2021. California Assembly Bill 1346 directs the California Air Resources Board to phase out the sale of gas-powered leaf blowers, lawn mowers and other small off-road engines by as soon as 2024. Lawmakers also approved \$30M in funds to be used for commercial rebates to go toward the purchase of electric equipment. Gardenland representatives will share further details on the implementation and timing of this legislation in both English and Spanish to educate the landscaping community.

Creating a Green Zone – representatives from the American Green Zone Alliance (AGZA.net) will attend the Zero-E Expo. AGZA engages municipalities, academic institutions, and private companies about the benefits of prudently implementing cleaner, low impact technologies and operations for the landscape maintenance industry.
